At its core, Crazy Time is a live dealer video game built around an enormous, vertically installed 54-segment wheel. Hosted by an energetic, live speaker in a vibrant, Willy Wonka-esque studio, the game streams in real-time to players around the world.

Unlike conventional table video games like blackjack or live roulette, Crazy Time requires no complex memorization of rules or technique charts. Players merely put bets on where they think the wheel will stop, making it available to absolute newbies while still offering the high volatility and massive win capacity that experienced gamblers crave.

How the Game is Played

Every video game round starts with a betting phase. Players have a minimal time to put their chips on one or more of the 8 available betting alternatives on the virtual layout. These choices include four numbers (1, 2, 5, and 10) and four distinct perk games.

When betting closes, the live host spins the huge wheel. At the same time, a separate two-reel slot placed above the main wheel-- known as the **Top Slot**-- spins along with it.

The Top Slot Mechanism

Before the wheel stops, the Top Slot generates a random multiplier and assigns it to one of the 8 betting alternatives on the wheel.

- If the Top Slot multiplier and the wheel outcome align on the same segment, the multiplier applies to that win.
- If the outcome is a bonus offer game, the multiplier boosts all the multipliers *inside* that particular benefit round, leading to potentially huge payments.

Comprehending the Wheel Segments and Payouts

The 54 sectors on the Crazy Time wheel are dispersed amongst numbers and bonus offer games. Naturally, the lower-paying numbers appear much more often on the wheel than the uncommon bonus offer rounds.

Breakdown of Wheel Segments

- **Number 1:** Appears 21 times (Payout: 1:1)
- **Number 2:** Appears 13 times (Payout: 2:1)
- **Number 5:** Appears 7 times (Payout: 5:1)
- **Number 10:** Appears 4 times (Payout: 10:1)
- **Coin Flip Bonus:** Appears 4 times
- **Cash Hunt Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Pachinko Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Crazy Time Bonus:** Appears 1 time

Dive Into the Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The true magic-- and the source of the video game's most significant payouts-- lies within its four interactive perk rounds. Whenever the wheel lands on a bonus offer section, gamers who positioned a bet on that specific function are transferred to a secondary game screen.

1. Coin Flip

The easiest of the four bonus offers, this round features a coin with a red side and a blue side.

- Each side is assigned a random multiplier before the flip.
- The host presses a button to flip the coin, and whichever color lands face-up awards the matching multiplier to the gamer's bet.

2. Money Hunt

This is a huge interactive shooting gallery featuring a screen with 108 random multipliers hidden behind numerous symbols (like a cactus, target, or chef's bitz.io hat).

- Players use a virtual crosshair to aim and shoot at a symbol of their option before a countdown timer expires.
- When time goes out, all symbols reveal their hidden multipliers, and the player wins whatever worth they shot.

3. Pachinko

Motivated by the traditional Japanese arcade game, Pachinko includes a big wall filled with physical pegs.

- The host drops a puck from the top of the board.

- The puck bounces randomly down the pegs till it lands in one of the slots at the bottom, which includes a multiplier.
- If the puck lands in a **"DOUBLE"** slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again for an even larger payment.

4. Crazy Time

The crown gem of the video game. When set off, the host opens a red door leading into a surreal, brightly colored virtual world featuring a huge, 64-segment mega-wheel.

- Players need to pick one of 3 flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow.**
- The host spins the wheel, and the flapper the player picked identifies their prize.
- This wheel includes **"DOUBLE"** and **"TRIPLE"** segments. If the flapper points to among these, all multipliers on the wheel multiply, and the wheel spins again-- allowing wins to scale up to the video game's optimum cap of 500,000 x!

Methods for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is eventually a game of opportunity determined by RNG and physics, gamers typically employ various wagering methods to handle their bankroll and optimize their time playing.

Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe/Conservative Strategy:** Betting greatly on the numbers (1 and 2) together with a small cover bet on the perk rounds. This method yields regular, smaller wins, keeping the bankroll steady for longer periods.
- **The Bonus-Only Strategy:** Ignoring the numbers entirely and putting little bets exclusively on the 4 bonus offer rounds (Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, and Crazy Time). This method is high-risk, high-reward, as it relies on striking the relatively uncommon benefit segments to see a return.
- **The Spread Strategy:** Placing bets throughout a variety of sectors (numbers and perks alike) to ensure that a high portion of the wheel yields some type of return.

Necessary Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed entertainment spending plan before logging in and never ever chase losses.
- **Understand Volatility:** Bonus rounds do not hit on every spin. Anticipate droughts while awaiting a benefit to activate.
- **Bet Entertainment:** Remember that live gambling establishment video games are created primarily for fun and home entertainment, not as a trustworthy source of earnings.
