The Anatomy of the Wheel

The Top Slot Feature: Amplifying the Action

Before every single spin of the main wheel, a secondary, two-reel fruit machine spins all at once above the main game. This is understood as the **Top Slot**.

- **Reel 1** display screens a segment of the wheel (either a number or a bonus offer video game).
- **Reel 2** screens a multiplier (ranging from 2x approximately 50x).

If the sign on the first reel aligns horizontally with the multiplier on the second reel, that multiplier is used to the corresponding segment for that round. If the wheel arrive at that particular sector, all wins for that result are multiplied. This function is where the capacity for massive payouts comes from.



Diving Into the Four Bonus Rounds

The real heart of Crazy Time lies in its four perk rounds. Landing on one of these sectors carries players out of the base video game and into a totally various, highly interactive environment.

1. Coin Flip

The most basic and most frequent perk round. A coin with a red side and a blue side is flipped by a mechanical flipper.

- Before the flip, random multipliers are appointed to both the red and blue sides.
- Whichever side lands face up awards the gamer the multiplier connected to it.

2. Money Hunt

This bonus offer transforms the screen into a huge shooting gallery featuring a 108-multiplier grid.

- The multipliers are arbitrarily shuffled and concealed behind various symbols (such as a cactus, target, or chef's hat).
- Players are provided a minimal countdown timer to goal and fire a cannon at the symbol of their option, revealing the hidden multiplier below. Because each gamer picks their own target, individual results will vary.

3. Pachinko

Motivated by the conventional Japanese arcade video game, Pachinko includes a glowing, vertical board filled with physical pegs.

- The speaker drops a puck from the top of the board.
- As the puck bounces randomly down through the pegs, it ultimately lands at the bottom in among numerous multiplier zones-- or on a "DOUBLE" slot, which doubles all multipliers on the board and triggers a drop-again.

4. Crazy Time

The holy grail of the video game. Striking this single section on the primary wheel opens a door to a jaw-dropping virtual world behind the studio wall.

- Players are greeted by a gigantic, 64-segment virtual wheel featuring three flippers (Blue, Green, and Yellow).
- Players need to select among the 3 flippers before the wheel spins.
- The wheel can reach shocking heights, using multipliers approximately 20,000 x if "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" sectors are struck along the way.

Popular Approaches and Play Styles

While Crazy Time is basically a video game of chance dictated by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and physical physics, gamers frequently embrace particular techniques to handle their bankroll and optimize their

time of entertainment.

- **The Low-Volatility Strategy (Conservative):**

- Focuses heavily on the number segments (1, 2, and 5) to secure frequent, smaller sized wins.
- Typically consists of little coverage bets on the perk rounds simply in case they hit.
- *Goal:* Prolong gameplay and minimize quick bankroll depletion.

- **The Bonus-Hunter Strategy (High Risk):**

- Ignores the mathematical segments totally or puts minimal bets on them.
- Assigns funds solely to the four perk rounds (*Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, and Crazy Time*).
- *Goal:* Position oneself to enter the high-paying mini-games, accepting that droughts between benefits are common.

- **The Balanced Approach:**

- Spreads bets uniformly throughout a mix of numbers and reward functions to keep a consistent balance while keeping the door open for big function hits.
