How Transactions Work: Steam API and P2P Trading

In the past, CS2 gambling sites utilized bots that straight traded with gamers by means of Steam accounts. Today, a lot of platforms use **Peer-to-Peer (P2P) systems**.

1. When a player wishes to deposit, the site pairs them with another gamer looking to cash out.
2. The transferring gamer sends out the skin straight to the buyer by means of a secure Steam trade link.
3. The site credits the depositor's account balance once the trade is validated.

This technique helps platforms prevent direct participation in dealing with Valve's stock items while keeping the virtual economy streaming.
