Close-up strengths tend to comprise:

- You can practice it essentially everywhere, inspite of confined area.
- It's bendy. If any person doesn't "get it," you possibly can shift to a one-of-a-kind final result with no changing your comprehensive setup.
- You can build rapport whereas acting, given that the trick is small satisfactory to share like a dialog.

But near-up additionally comes with actual constraints. Distance is a complication, now not simply the target audience. Your digital camera distance, your lighting fixtures, and your place count number.
