Why Does the Timeline of Delay Transform a Contained Problem into a Spreading Crisis?

The first 2 to 4 weeks of mold growth are the most critical. During this window, the colony is still localized and surface-level on most materials. After 30 days of continuous moisture exposure, mold begins deep colonization—spreading into wall cavities, HVAC systems, and insulation batts where you cannot see it. By week 12, the contamination has often reached multiple rooms through air ducts and structural pathways.

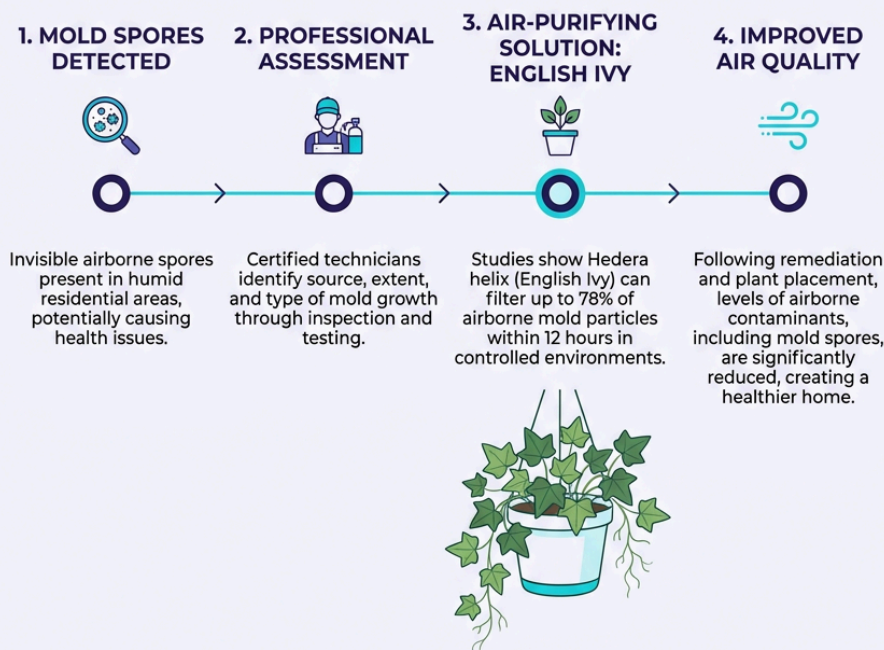
