- **XP Requirement:** Players should level up their profile by using official Valve servers (Casual, Competitive, Premier, Deathmatch) to make their first weekly drop.
- **The Bundle:** Upon reaching the needed XP for the very first level-up of the week, gamers are provided with a selection of products (normally an option between weapons and cases).

### Legitimate Ways to Get Free CS: GO Cases

While the in-game weekly drop is the main technique, gamers can utilize several methods to optimize their chances of getting cases.

#### 1. Playing on Official Valve Servers (Weekly Drops)

- **Upgrade to Prime Status:** Non-prime accounts seldom get valuable drops and are omitted from the weekly care plan system. Getting Prime is essential for anybody major about collecting free items.
- **Play Regularly Throughout the Week:** Don't cram all your playtime into one day. The XP needed for subsequent drops increases a little, making a constant pace more efficient.
- **Keep an Eye on the Active Drop Pool:** When Valve updates the active case swimming pool, older cases transfer to the uncommon drop swimming pool and frequently value in value in time. Holding onto dropped cases can be a clever monetary relocation.

3. **Imposter Bots:** Be careful of users claiming to be Steam Support or popular traders using totally free items in exchange for little favors.

### Can I still secure free CS: GO cases in Counter-Strike 2?

Getting complimentary CS: GO/CS2 cases requires perseverance, consistency, and a healthy dosage of care. By playing regularly on main servers with a Prime account, players can gradually build up cases to either cost Steam Wallet funds or evaluate their luck with a secret. Always focus on account security, avoid too-good-to-be-true free gift websites, and delight in the grind!
