How much does a locksmith cost depends on the job

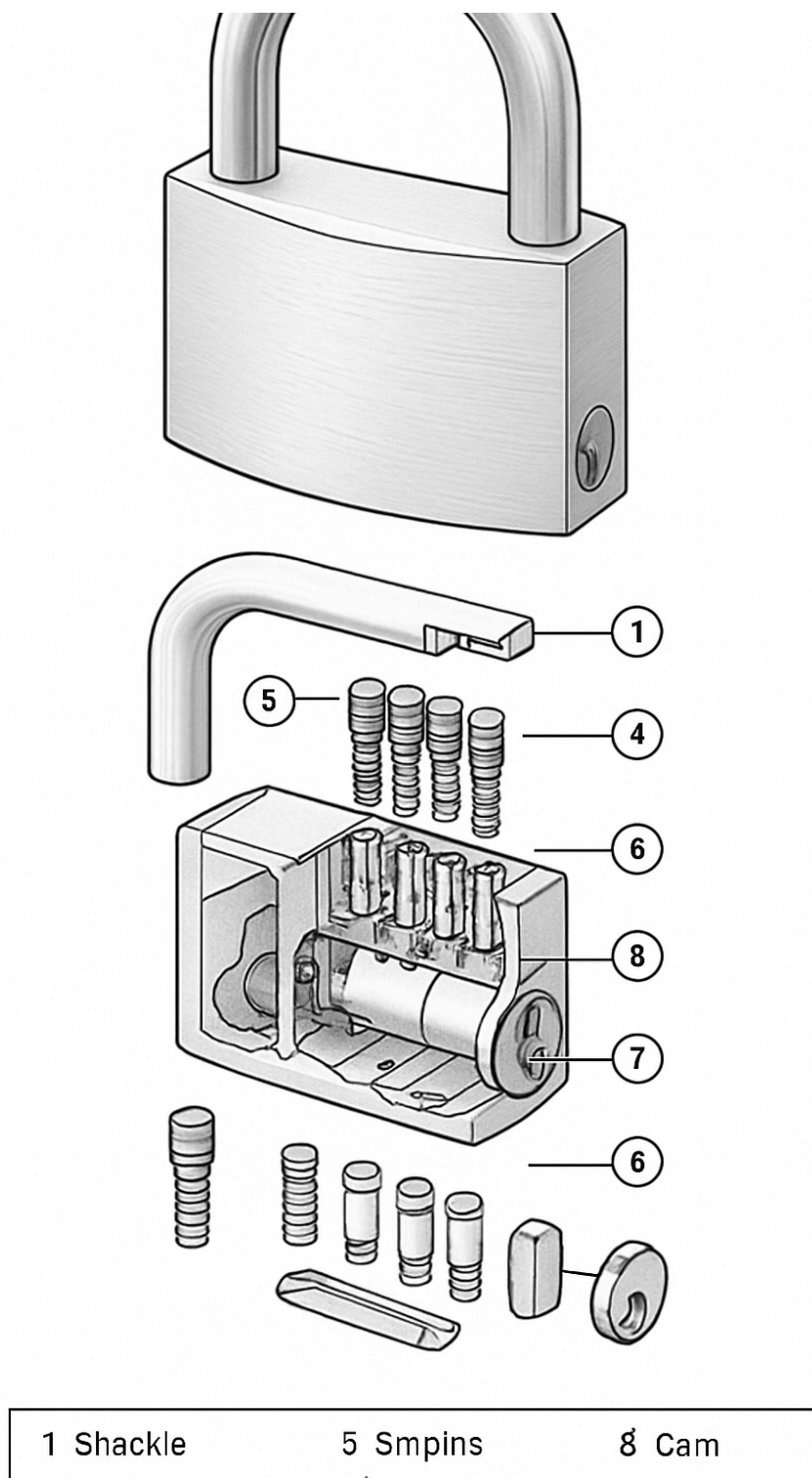
