The birthday person might discover prematurely. A vendor might be late or deliver the wrong thing. Attendees might be early and ruin the surprise. The weather might not cooperate.

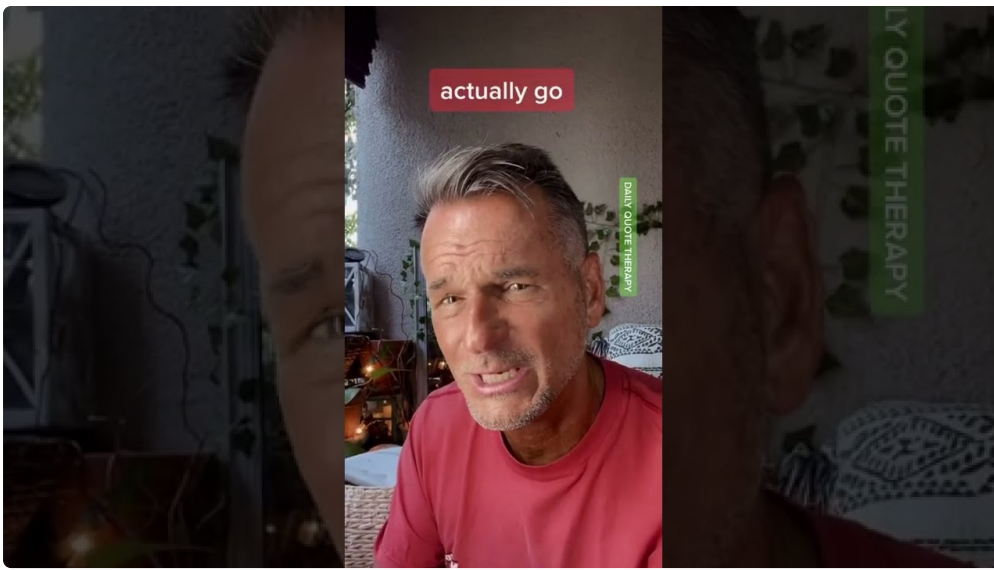


The encouraging thing is that a skilled coordinator has seen it all before and has backup strategies in place.
