A long lasting, razor area starts long until now paint hits the wall. We consider it in layers. The substrate have to be sound, scuffed to simply accept end, and freed from oils. The intersection needs to be instantly and defect free, or we make it straight with caulk, spackle, or a easy skim. The primer locks down porosity so that topcoat builds evenly. The lower line is carried by a broom with the appropriate flagging and load, or by way of a tape edge that is burnished, then sealed with a preventive cross. The completing strokes are laid wet into moist, with even tension and no discontinue marks.
