More remarkable is warding off day after day swings. Humidity comes next. Keep it around 60 to 70 p.c so corks remain supple. Dip underneath 50 p.c. for long stretches, and corks can dry. Light should always be light and indirect. UV is the enemy of delicate flavors, and shiny, warm bulbs generate the very temperatures you are trying to ward off. Vibration concerns too, that is why I hinder mounting racks to thin, resonant panels.
