Understanding the Top Slot and Multipliers

Before every spin of the main wheel, a smaller two-reel fruit machine located directly above the wheel-- referred to as the **Top Slot**-- spins simultaneously.

- **How it works:** The Top Slot creates one random wheel segment (a number or a perk video game) and pairs it with a random multiplier varying from 2x to 50x.
- **The Result:** If the main wheel lands on the precise sector revealed in the Top Slot, the multiplier is applied to that spin. If it is a number bet, the payment is multiplied. If it is a reward video game, the multipliers within the benefit round are enhanced accordingly.

If the puck arrive at a "DOUBLE," all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** Only 1 section on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** Players step behind a red door into a vibrant, surreal virtual world featuring an enormous 64-segment wheel. The host chooses among 3 flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel spins, and whatever multiplier the chosen flapper points to is awarded. Like Pachinko, this wheel features "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" segments, permitting multipliers to rise to an incredible 20,000 x.
