VOC limits had been tight, scent had to be near zero via Monday at 7 a.m. We detailed a low-scent acrylic device with two-hour recoat, coordinated with construction leadership to run the air handlers in a single day, and sequenced treatment rooms first, corridors last. Furniture used to be staged centrally in every one room, masked in blocks. A six-grownup staff complete by using Sunday nighttime, and personnel walked right into a smooth, competent area Monday morning. The relevant option become product determination and HVAC coordination, no longer painting speed by myself.

## **Guardrails that conserve nice when time is tight**

Speed devoid of necessities produces callbacks. A written punch list, a dry-time chart taped to the door, and a very last pale-check prevent these.
