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If you own a home in Arlington, you already know what our climate does to exterior surface areas. One wet spring and a shaded side of your house can begin growing algae. A couple of seasons of pollen and traffic dust will turn a brilliant driveway dull gray. Brick actions get slick. Composite decks collect mildew in the grain.

A careful contractor will either prevent those locations or shield them, not merely spray and hope.



Vegetation matters too. Lots of power washing services are technically "naturally degradable," however that does not suggest your shrubs will delight in a direct hit of concentrated chemical. Plants can be pre-wet, gently covered, and rinsed once again after treatment. On hot days, that extra care can be the difference between healthy landscaping and curled brown leaves 2 days later.

If you have animals or small children, ask about dwell times and rinsing.
