* Note: "Surr" stands for Late Surrender (if readily available). "S/D" means Double if enabled, otherwise Stand.

Key Rules to Look for in Live Casinos

Not all live blackjack tables are produced equal. Before joining a virtual seat, players should carefully analyze the specific rules of the table, as they directly impact your house edge.

- **Blackjack Payouts:** Always look for tables that pay **3:2** for a natural blackjack. Avoid tables that pay **6:5**, as this substantially increases your home advantage.
- **Dealer Soft 17 Rule:** Check whether the dealer should hit or stand on a soft 17 (an Ace and a 6). A dealer standing on soft 17 is more beneficial to the player.
- **Double Down Restrictions:** Some tables restrict doubling down to tough totals of 10 and 11 only, while others allow doubling on any 2 cards. The latter is constantly better for the player.
- **Splitting Rules:** Look for tables that enable gamers to divide pair to 3 or 4 times (resulting in multiple hands) and those that permit doubling down after splitting (DAS).

- **Surrender Option:** Late surrender allows a gamer to forfeit half their bet if they dislike their preliminary two-card hand versus the dealer's strong upcard. While uncommon, it is an important rule for decreasing losses.
