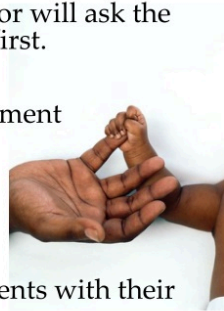




Mediation Process
