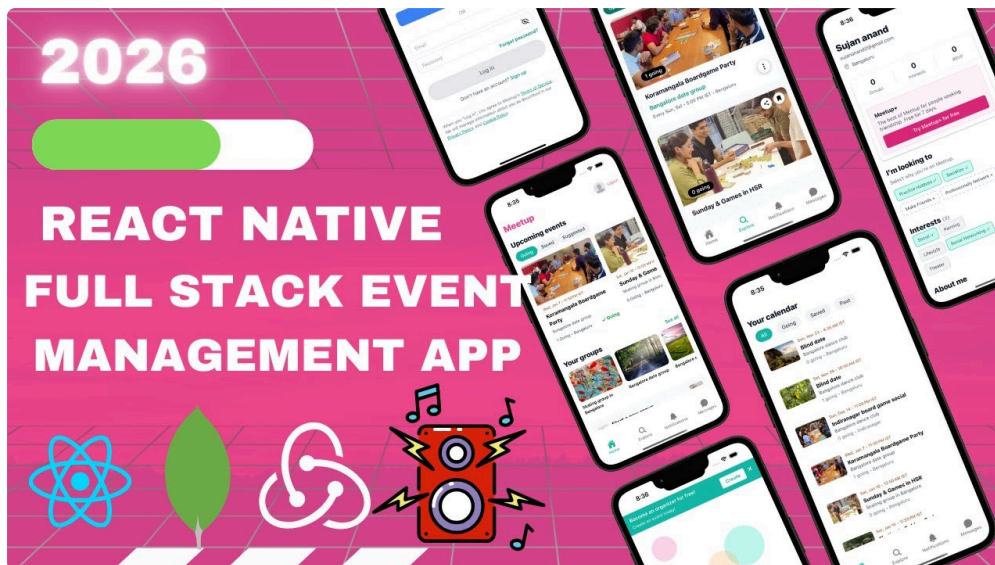
On the day of the session , the professional planner 's role is essential for success. With clear responsibilities managing different aspects of the Q&A, your coordinator will deliver a smooth experience.
