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Walk through any Arlington neighborhood in April and you see the exact same story on a lot of homes: green film approaching siding, dark stripes on gutters, streaks on the driveway, and brick steps that get slick after a rain. The mix of humidity, tree cover, pollen, and road salt in Northern Virginia is rough on exterior surfaces. A great professional can make a home look five years more youthful in an afternoon. A bad one can engrave your brick, scar your deck, or void your roof guarantee simply as fast.

House washing

When I assess house washing jobs, I take note of three things. First, whether the contractor discusses securing electric outlets, light fixtures, door limits, and any locations where water can be required within. Second, whether they inquire about previous water intrusion problems or recent window replacements. Third, whether they point out cleaning the underside of gutters and soffits, which typically hold the most noticeable staining.



On older brick rowhouses or painted masonry near Lyon Village or Aurora Highlands, an experienced pro will dial the pressure way down and prioritize chemistry and dwell time. High pressure on [Power Washing Arlington VA](#)

old mortar can accelerate falling apart and leave wand marks that become obvious once the wall dries.

Roof washing

Roof cleaning is where the space in between specialists and "guy with a device" becomes stark.

Asphalt shingle roofs with black streaks are extremely common in Arlington. Those streaks are usually a kind of algae referred to as *Gloeocapsa magma*. The right method to resolve them is a soft wash using a very low-pressure application of a solution primarily based on salt hypochlorite (similar to household bleach, however stronger and carefully blended), plus surfactants, followed by a thorough rinse where appropriate.

Two points separate careful contractors from the rest. The very first is how they speak about your maker's warranty. Many shingle manufacturers clearly warn versus high pressure on roofs. If a professional recommends blasting the shingles at close range, they are inviting granular loss and premature aging. The 2nd is how they secure your residential or commercial property while they work. Roof runoff can stress plants, stain metals, and leave streaks if not managed. The team must be prepared to tarp or pre-wet susceptible landscaping and display downspouts.

Tile, metal, and flat roofs each require different methods. In many cases, a professional might in fact advise not cleaning a specific roof section if the threat outweighs the reward, for example on extremely brittle, old shingles over a shallow pitch. A candid "not worth doing" action is a good indication that you are speaking to a professional, not a salesperson.



Concrete, brick, and stone flatwork

Driveways, pathways, outdoor patios, and parking pads are usually managed with higher pressure, however even here, blunt force is not the entire story.

For power washing Arlington VA on concrete and masonry flatwork, I try to find 3 parts. First, pre-treatment with the best cleaner. Organic staining from algae or mildew reacts to one kind of chemical profile, while oil spots and rust require another. Third, attention to drain and next-door neighbors, especially in tight metropolitan settings where dirty runoff can stream onto surrounding residential or commercial property or public sidewalks.

On historic clay brick or flagstone strolls, specifically in older neighborhoods, the technician should stabilize cosmetic goals against the integrity of the product. Aggressive cleaning can get rid of the natural patina that in fact helps secure the surface. Decks, fences, and outdoor structures

Wood behaves differently than masonry or vinyl. It is permeable, expands with moisture, and can scar or "fuzz" when over-pressured.

The best approach is normally lower pressure, a little higher water volume, and detergents fit to the coating on the wood.
