- Licenses from nations that signed the **1968 Vienna Convention on Road Traffic** can usually be exchanged straight, though tests might be needed depending on bilateral agreements and residency duration.
- Licenses from countries under the **1949 Geneva Convention** normally need passing the theoretical state exam.

Yes. A PESEL number (or a substitute tax identifier in specific short-lived cases) is compulsory for developing your PKK profile and registering for tests in Poland.
