Years ago I watched a junior painter pull tape on a mint and white stripe wall with no sealing. Every stripe had fuzzy edges. We stripped, reprime, and redo the accent walls at our cost. We not ever skipped that sealer step once again.

Trim, doors, and cupboards: where paint meets profile

Trim portray offerings call for a steadier hand because profiles shift less than your brush. The trick is to discover a reference plane, on a regular basis the flat on the prime of a baseboard or the demonstrate at a door casing. The staff pulled tape in stay sections within half-hour of the final pass even though yet another painter trailed with a clean microfiber to capture any weepers. That aspect nevertheless seems to be freshly cut when I walk prior years later.



Safety and ergonomics avoid lines straight
