2. Utility Synergy

Tossing utility randomly wastes valuable resources. Reliable teams coordinate their energy to accomplish specific objectives:

- **Flashbangs:** Pop-flashes that detonate instantly in the opponent's field of vision, denying them a possibility to look away.
- **Molotovs/Incendiaries:** Used to clear tight angles (like "Newell" on Inferno or "Banana") and delay enemy pushes.
- **Smokes:** Block sniper lanes and isolate bomb sites throughout execution.

3. Map Control and Defaulting

- Spreading out across the map requires the CTs to expose their positioning.
