1. The AWP|Dragon Lore

Possibly the most famous skin in the video game, the Dragon Lore features a mythical dragon breathing fire throughout the body of the sniper rifle. Initially dropped exclusively on specific maps like Cobblestone during significant tournaments, these memento packages are now extremely rare. A Factory New Souvenir Dragon Lore signed by superstar gamer Skadoodle famously cost over £ 60,000 years earlier, and rates have actually only escalated since.

2. The AK-47|Case Hardened (Pattern 661 "Blue Gem")

While a basic Case Hardened AK-47 is relatively budget-friendly, the top-tier pattern indices-- specifically Pattern 661-- cover nearly the whole top receiver of the weapon in a beautiful, reflective blue. Because the odds of unboxing this specific pattern with an excellent float value are astronomically low, these items have actually commanded private deals exceeding 6 figures.

3. StatTrak™ M4A4|Howl

The Howl is special because it holds historic significance. Valve eliminated the original artwork due to a copyright infringement claim, making the skin "Contraband." Valve upgraded the design and stopped it from dropping completely. Anybody holding a Howl at that time kept it, developing a permanently capped supply.
