

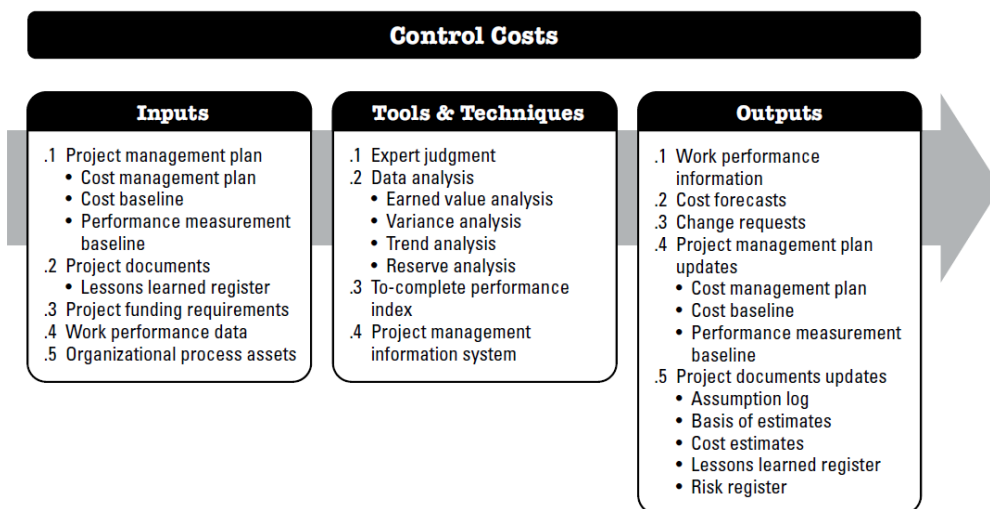


Figure 7-10. Control Costs: Inputs, Tools & Techniques, and Outputs
