- **The Martingale System:** A high-risk strategy where gamers double their bet after every loss, trying to recover all previous losses plus an earnings with a single win.
- **The Moonshot:** Ignoring little multipliers entirely and intending exclusively for high numbers (10x, 50x, or more). This requires a large bankroll and severe patience.
