Backs and bottoms remember. A quarter-inch back stapled on is immediate however flexes. I like 1/2-inch backs captured in a dado, glued and pinned. It stiffens the case and makes anchoring dependable. Shelf pin holes get drilled with jigs that hinder spacing distinct. A crooked line of holes is sort of a crooked smile. You become aware of it each time.

Before finish, the whole lot will get dry healthy. Doors dangle on their supposed hinges. Drawers experience the slides supposed for them. This is in which I trap a millimeter that wants shaving or an cease panel that wishes a marginally greater scribe. Paint, stain, and topcoat choices
