Comprehending the Top Slot

Before the primary wheel is spun in each round, a different two-reel slot machine located above the primary wheel-- called the **Top Slot**-- spins all at once.

- **Reel 1** screens one of the betting sections (numbers or reward video games).
- **Reel 2** display screens a multiplier worth (varying from 2x up to 50x).

If the randomly produced mix on the Top Slot lines up on the horizontal payline, the multiplier is applied to that specific sector for the upcoming spin. If the wheel arrive at a number segment improved by the Top Slot, the payout for that number is multiplied appropriately. If the Top Slot pairs with a benefit game, all multipliers within that perk round are multiplied by the designated value.

The Four Immersive Bonus Rounds

1. Coin Flip

The Coin Flip is the most often occurring benefit video game.

- **The Outcome:** Whichever side faces upward when the coin lands determines the winning multiplier for all players who wager on the Coin Flip sector.

2. Money Hunt

Money Hunt looks like a traditional shooting gallery video game presented on a massive digital wall.

- **The Mechanic:** The screen shows a grid consisting of 108 random multipliers, which are then covered by different signs (such as a cactus, target, or chef hat) and mixed.
- **The Outcome:** Players utilize an on-screen crosshair to select a target within a restricted timeframe. Once time expires, all targets reveal their concealed multipliers, and the player gets the multiplier representing their chosen spot.

3. Pachinko

Inspired by the standard Japanese arcade game, the Pachinko bonus offer includes a big physical wall filled with pegs.

- **The Mechanic:** The live host drops a puck from the top of the board. The puck bounces arbitrarily through the pegs until it settles at the bottom in one of a number of landing zones, each containing a multiplier.
- **The Special Rule:** If the puck lands in a zone marked "**DOUBLE**," all multipliers at the bottom of the board double in value, and the host drops the puck a 2nd time. This can repeat till the optimum payout cap is reached.

4. Crazy Time

The name perk round occurs behind a red door, leading players into a fantastical, augmented-reality virtual world.

- **The Mechanic:** Inside this virtual space stands a huge wheel with 64 segments and three flappers (green, blue, and yellow).
- **The Player's Role:** Before the wheel is spun, the individual needs to pick one of the 3 flappers.
- **The Outcome:** The wheel spins and eventually stops. The player wins the multiplier shown by their chosen flapper. Simply like Pachinko, landing on a "**DOUBLE**" or "**TRIPLE**" section increases all worths on the wheel, and the host spins once again, possibly leading to substantial multipliers.
