The trick is that your reaction becomes element of the overall performance. You don't simply resolution, you switch the solution right into a beat.

Then I practice an movement that communicates regulate: an empty-hand gesture, a clean show, a staged resolution, or a repeatable handling that proves the right aspect.

Your viewers desires to feel such as you're cooperating. When you pivot without brushing aside them, individuals remain with you.

## **"Where did it move?" Turning location questions into reveals**

## **Make the target audience suppose wise, not fooled**
