- Special eligibility programs for educators, nonprofits, or developers

There is no official, one-size-fits-all, time-limited free trial for everyone. Trial length, credit card requirements, and whether you're billed automatically at the end depend on the promotion you qualified for.

Because these offers vary, your trial might last 7, 14, or even 30 days — or sometimes a different length depending on the campaign.

Warning: If your free trial requires a credit card, be aware it might auto-renew to a paid subscription unless you cancel before the trial ends. Always review the terms carefully to avoid surprise charges.

How to Find Your ChatGPT Trial End Date or Renewal Date

Want to find your exact ChatGPT renewal date or trial end date? The best place to check is **Settings > Subscription** inside your ChatGPT account. Here's how to get there and what to look for.

Step-By-Step: Check Your Subscription Status in ChatGPT

1. **Log in to your ChatGPT account** at chat.openai.com.

ChatGPT Confirmation Email: Another Place to Check Dates

After upgrading or starting a trial, you should receive a confirmation email from OpenAI with your subscription details. This email typically includes:

- Your plan name (e.g., ChatGPT Plus or Plus trial)
- Start date of your subscription or trial
- Trial end date (if applicable)
- Renewal date and amount to be charged (if auto-renewing)

If you can't find your renewal date in your account's settings, take a look inside your inbox and spam/junk folder for this confirmation email from OpenAI.



Warning: Don't ignore this confirmation email! It's your best friend for avoiding "surprise" charges or misunderstandings about when your trial or subscription is ending.

Why Doesn't My Free Plan Have a Trial End Date?

The free plan is not a trial, so it never expires. It's essentially a forever-free tier with limited access that you can use indefinitely. You'll see "Free Plan" in **Settings > Subscription** without any end date listed.

What If I Signed Up for a Trial Without Providing a Credit Card?

Some trial offers do not require upfront payment and won't auto-renew. Others require credit card details and switch <https://suprmind.ai/hub/chatgpt/free-trial/> to paid Plus automatically if you don't cancel. Check your confirmation email or your subscription settings to confirm details.
