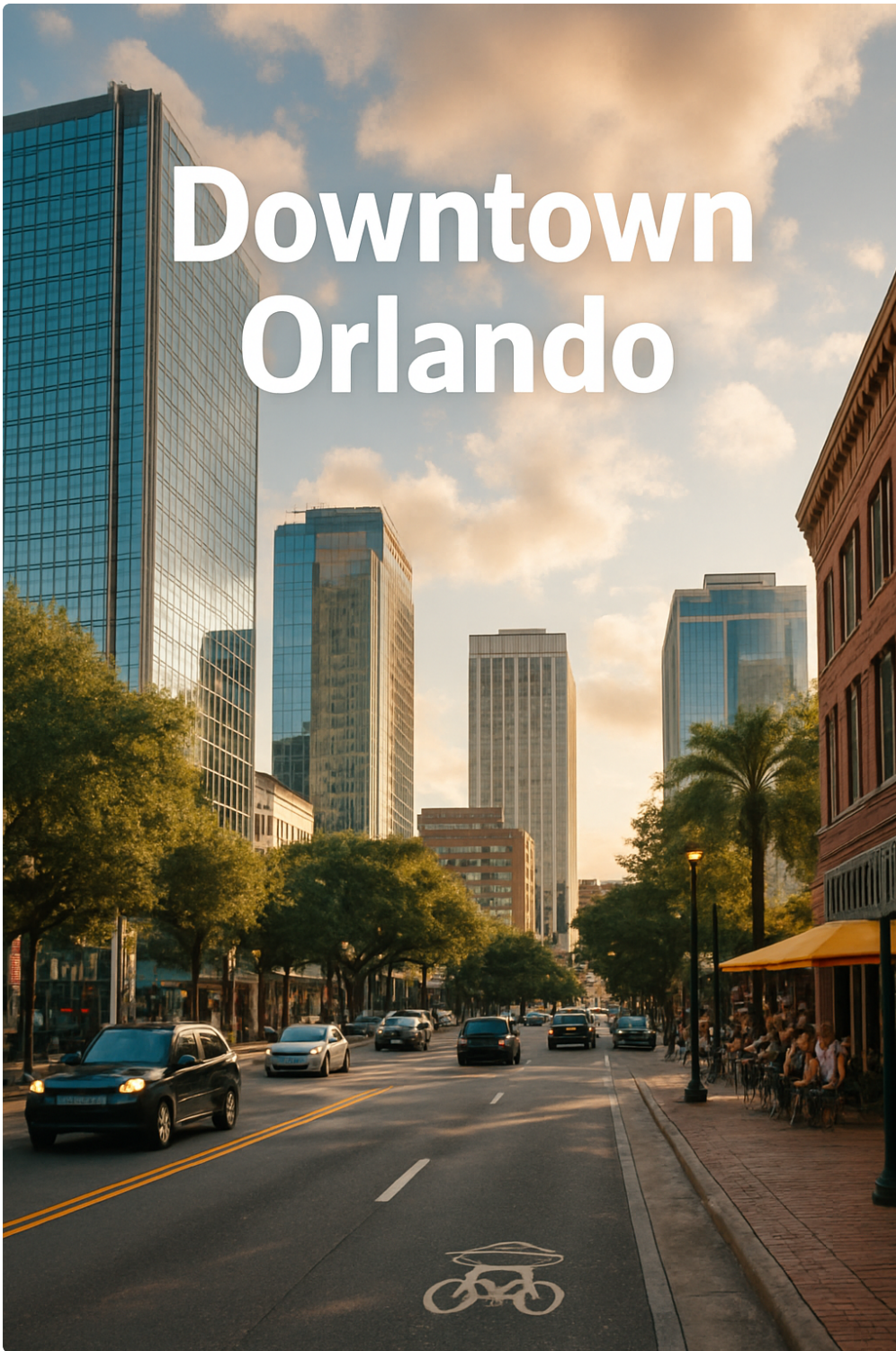
How to judge a local locksmith without overcomplicating it
