Advantages and disadvantages of Going Cheap

Advantages

- **Low financial danger**-- Even a streak of "misfortune" won't heavily affect the bankroll.
- **High volume of openings**-- Players can open much more cases for the exact same quantity invested in a premium case.
- **Knowing chance**-- Newcomers can practice unboxing mechanics without sensation pressured by high stakes.

Drawbacks

- **Focus on "sticker label" cases**-- Some low-cost cases include valuable sticker labels (e.g., Cologne 2015). Stickers can often go beyond the case cost.

- **Combine cases with "Case Hardening" drops**-- Certain skins, like the "Case Hardened Blue Gem," have high resale worth despite the case's low expense.
- **Usage "Buy-and-Hold" for unusual Covert items**-- If a Covert skin drops, hold it up until need rises (e.g., during a tournament).

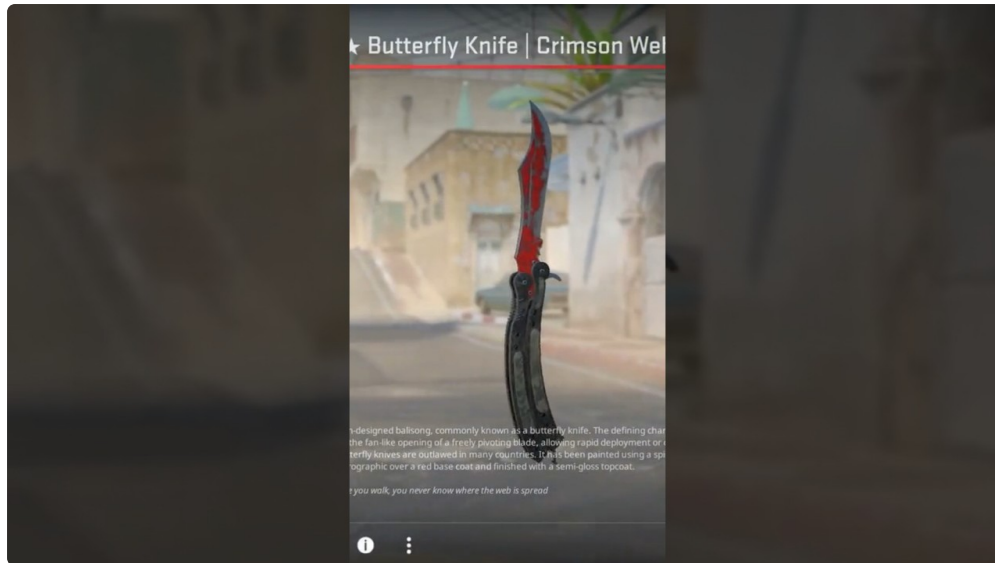
