We sprayed a dedicated adhesion primer, sanded to 320, then sprayed two coats of a waterborne alkyd satin. Doors held on day four, with bumpers mounted to ward off sticking. The owner waited per week formerly loading cabinets. Total time, 8 running days with a 4 man or woman team, simply over four hundred linear ft of trim, 17 doorways, and 34 cupboard pieces. Three months later, we did a courtesy money. No blocking, no sags, and the stairwell looked flat at sunset.
