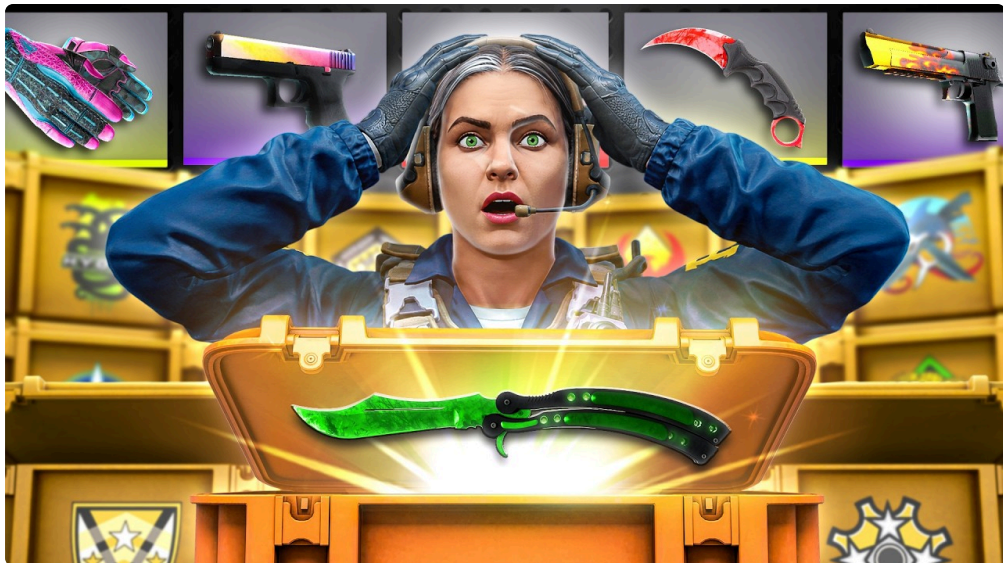

Note: The "Rare Special Item" tier is the most desired, containing knife and glove skins that frequently command premium prices on the market.

Actions to Open a CS2 Case (Checklist)

- **Verify the case type**-- Ensure you have the correct case for the essential you plan to use.
- **Inspect key availability**-- Purchase a key from the in-game store or a respectable third-party seller.
- **Set a budget plan**-- Decide ahead of time how much you are ready to spend; never surpass it.
- **Open the case**-- Follow the in-game prompts (Case → Insert Key → Open).
- **Inspect the outcome**-- After the animation, see the skin's float worth and market price.
