Old, flaking movie gets scraped to a firm edge, then sanded to feather the transition. For bare wooden, I sand to 80 or a hundred grit on floors, a little finer, 120 to a hundred and fifty, on railings the place fingers think every thing. I invariably countersink popped fasteners and swap corroded screws for stainless or lined structural screws. On patios, I degrease with a citrus solvent where grills have dripped, then use a drive wash at reliable distance. 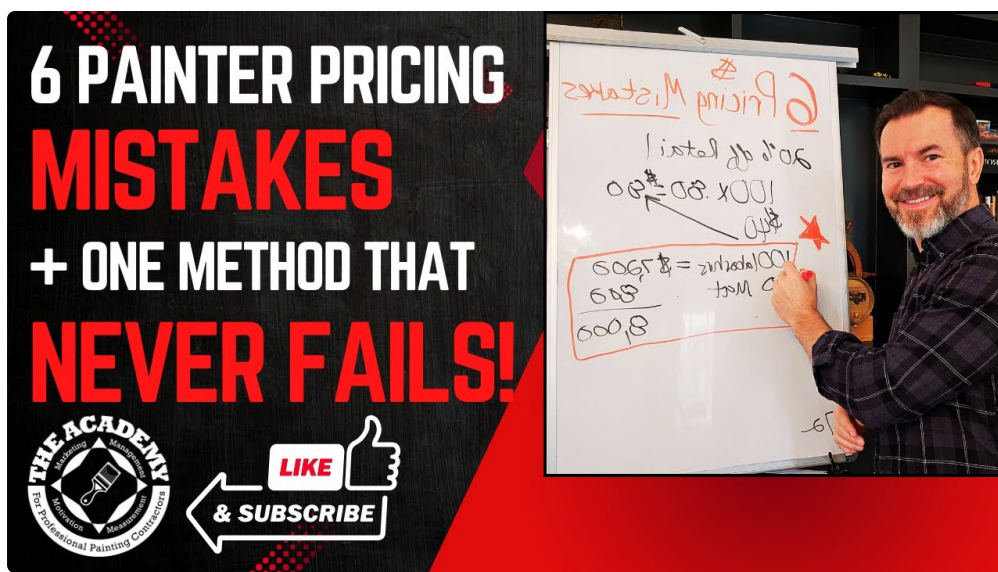
