A story of two projects

A retail midsection repaint looked clear-cut: two single-story structures, stucco facades, metal canopies. The low bidder scheduled a 3-week period. We authorised a mid-diversity bidder who insisted on four weeks and certain elastomeric over a masonry primer, zinc primer on canopies, and urethane topcoats for the metal. Week one published hairline cracking throughout super faces and chalky surfaces that failed the tape experiment. The slower contractor had planned for multiplied tension washing, chalk-binding primer, and patching with elastomeric knife-grade filler. They achieved on day 26. Five years later the faces nonetheless appear sparkling, and the canopy color is consistent. A neighboring center painted the comparable yr with inexpensive acrylic, and its cover faded badly inside two summers.

At a scientific office development, a tenant improvement which is called for a quick repaint of corridors, doorways, and examination rooms. The first concept used familiar acrylic in eggshell all over the world. Our facilities lead flagged cleanability and chosen scent stages. We pivoted to a low-scent, scrub-resistant acrylic for partitions, waterborne alkyd tooth for doorways and frames, and scheduled nighttime work for corridors with a weekend blitz on exam rooms. The team used air scrubbers and a light submit-cure bake via bumping HVAC. Monday morning occupancy went smoothly, and the protection group experiences fewer scuffs that require touch-up greater than a yr later.

What to ask for the duration of the walkthrough

Walkthroughs make or ruin estimating accuracy. Invite the contractor to lead the conversation, then fill inside the gaps. I ask them to discover substrates, factor out complication components, and advise prep. 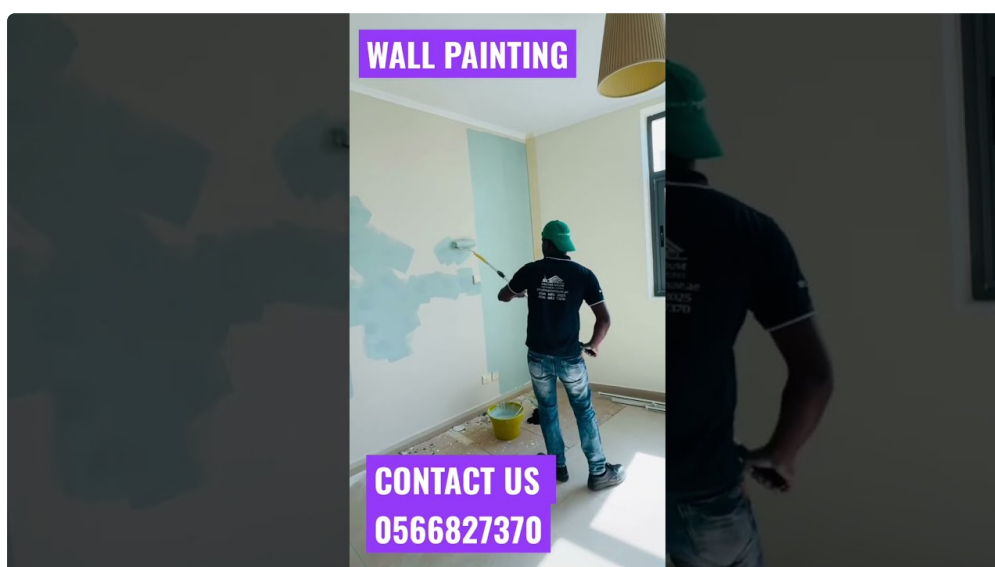
