What is Crazy Time?

At its core, *Crazy Time* is a live dealer video game show hosted by a passionate, energetic speaker. The focal point of the video game is a massive, vertically mounted wheel consisting of 54 segments. Gamers position bets on the section they think the wheel will stop on.

While the concept sounds basic, the combination of a **Top Slot**-- a secondary two-reel slot device that spins all at once with the main wheel-- injects random multipliers into every single round. If the Top Slot lines up a bet type with a multiplier, every win connected with that bet is drastically improved.



The Wheel Breakdown

To comprehend how the video game works, one need to take a look at the bitz.io layout of the 54 segments. The wheel is divided into numbers (1, 2, 5, and 10) and 4 benefit round sectors.

As seen in the table above, the lower numbers appear most often, while the profitable perk rounds are much rarer, adding high-volatility enjoyment to the gameplay.

The Four Wild and Wonderful Bonus Rounds

The real magic of *Crazy Time* depend on its four bonus offer games. Triggering one of these rounds transfers gamers from the primary studio into immersive, interactive enhanced reality mini-games.

1. Coin Flip

This is the simplest and most regular benefit round.

- **How it works:** A coin with a red side and a blue side is flipped by a mechanical flipper.

- **The Payout:** Before the flip, random multipliers are appointed to both the red and blue sides. Whichever side lands deal with up determines the multiplier used to the gamer's stake.

2. Money Hunt

Step up to a massive virtual shooting gallery.

- **How it works:** The screen displays a grid of 108 random multipliers concealed behind different signs (like a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat).
- **The Payout:** Players utilize an on-screen cannon to intend and contend one sign before a countdown timer expires. Once the timer ends, all signs expose their hidden multipliers, and the player wins whatever worth their picked sign hidden.

3. Pachinko

Inspired by the standard Japanese arcade video game, Pachinko is all about gravity and anticipation.

- **How it works:** The dealership drops a puck from the top of a glowing purple Pachinko wall filled with physical pegs. The puck bounces arbitrarily down the board up until it lands in one of the landing zones at the bottom.
- **The Payout:** Each zone includes a multiplier. If the puck lands in a "DOUBLE" zone, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped again for huge possible payments.

4. Crazy Time

The ultimate feature of the game, taking location behind a huge red door.

- **How it works:** The host opens the door to expose a surreal, giant virtual wheel with 64 segments and three flippers (Green, Blue, and Yellow).
- **The Payout:** The gamer should pick one of the three flippers. The wheel is spun, and whichever multiplier the selected flipper indicate when the wheel stops is granted to the gamer. Simply like Pachinko, landing on "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" increases all worths on the wheel for a re-spin.

- **Covering the Board:** Some gamers select to spread out little bets throughout numerous numbers and perk rounds to ensure they have a stake in almost every spin. However, this requires careful bankroll management, as covering too numerous results can rapidly deplete funds if low-paying numbers keep striking.
