People with unusual heart palpitations may have have cherry angioma.

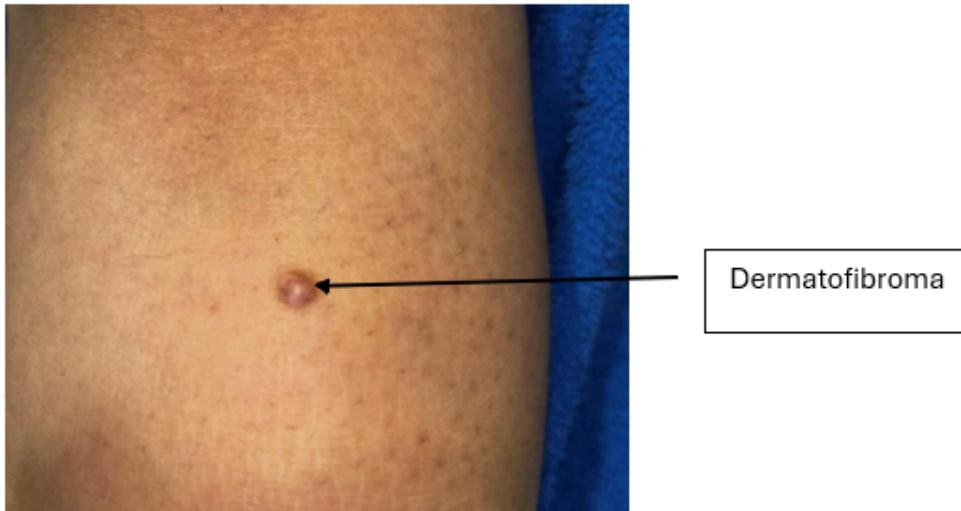
Weather conditions and excessive exposure to the sun may cause angioma. UV exposure destroys cellular DNA on the outermost skin layers and also stimulates skin aging.
