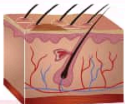
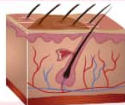
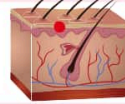
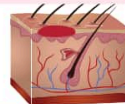
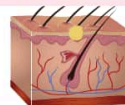
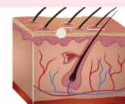
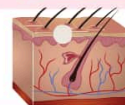
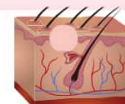
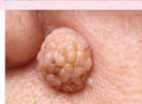
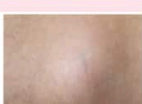
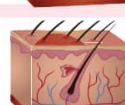




Primary Skin Lesions Chart
