- **Standout Skins:** AK-47|Nightwish, MP9|Starlight Protector.
- **Why it's great:** Almost every tier features lively, extremely in-depth community-made designs. Moreover, it features the coveted Gamma Doppler knife surfaces, making the possible payout from a rare unique item remarkably high.

2. Recoil Case

The **Recoil Case** was introduced late in CS: GO's active lifecycle, however it quickly ended up being a fan favorite due to its high-tier weapon selections.

- **Standout Skins:** AWP|Neo-Noir, USP-S|Printstream.
- **Why it's fantastic:** The addition of the Printstream finish for the USP-S (and its existing popularity on the M4A1-S and Desert Eagle) drove huge need. In addition, the lower-tier skins like the AK-47|Head Shot preserve solid market price.

3. Prisma 2 Case

For players going after colorful, anime-inspired, or lively sci-fi aesthetic <https://cs2skin.com/cases> appeals, the **Prisma 2 Case** is a leading contender.

- **Standout Skins:** M4A1-S|Gamer Two, AK-47|Phantom Disruptor.
- **Why it's great:** The M4A1-S|Player Two is a fan-favorite among gamers who choose playful, lively designs over military-sim visual appeals. Paired with Horizon-series knives, it provides an excellent balance of affordability and visual appeal.

4. Operation Broken Fang Case

Operations constantly present renowned cases, and **Broken Fang** sticks out due to its addition of agent skins (at the time) and high-demand weapon surfaces.

- **Standout Skins:** M4A4|Cyber Security, AWP|Exoskeleton.
- **Why it's terrific:** This case features the specialized glove pool rather of standard knives. Gloves like Driver Gloves|Snow Leopard and Specialist Gloves|Marble Fade remain a few of the most popular products in the video game, keeping the worth of this case steadily climbing up.

5. CS20 Case
