

A stuck garage door has an unique talent for choosing the worst possible minute. Wipe the lenses with a soft fabric. Ensure both indicator lights are on strong. If one blinks, shake the sensor till it glows gradually, after that tighten its bracket. ## **Weather strip, limit, and puffy wood**

The opener dutifully attempts to push the door into the seal, then turns around. Run your hand along the top and sides when the door is closed. If the seal holds like a suction cup, a small trim of the seal lip or an airplane of a swollen side can release it. Bottom seals harden throughout the years and surge, which can grab

on an increased threshold or a spot of heaved concrete. Replacing a lower seal and leveling a threshold strip takes under an hour and often removes a persistent catch.

## Opener force and travel limitations, the peaceful culprits

Most openers have two pairs of adjustments: travel limitations that define exactly how far the door goes up and down, and force setups that control how much resistance sets off a stop or reverse. If your door closes to within a couple of inches of the floor then backs up, the down travel limit may be set too brief. If it pounds the floor and jumps, the restriction is established too long.

- Reconnect the door to the opener if disengaged, then run the door to mid-travel.
- Locate the travel restriction screws or digital setups on the opener head. Mark existing setups with tape.

- If the door turns around on call, minimize down pressure a little and retest.
- Once down is proper, adjust the up restriction so the door gets rid of the header without hitting the opener's stop.
