- **The Conservative Approach (Auto-Cashout at 1.1 x - 1.3 x):** Players protected little, frequent wins. While a sudden 1.00 x crash eliminates profits, this technique yields high win rates gradually.

- **The Martingale System:** A high-risk strategy where players double their bet after every loss, trying to recover all previous losses plus a revenue with a single win.
- **The Moonshot:** Ignoring small multipliers totally and aiming specifically for high numbers (10x, 50x, or more). This requires a big bankroll and severe patience.

## Part 2: Technical Troubles-- Fixing Actual CSGO/ CS2 Crashes

### Repairing Checklist

- **Verify Integrity of Game Files:**
  - Open Steam.
  - Go to the Library, right-click the game, and choose **Properties**.
  - Navigate to the **Installed Files** tab and click **Verify stability of video game files**.
- **Update Graphics Drivers:**
  - Visit NVIDIA GeForce Experience or AMD Adrenalin to download the current steady drivers. Perform a tidy installation if possible.
- **Lower In-Game Settings:**
  - Drop high-intensity settings like particle information, shadow quality, and ambient occlusion. Change from Fullscreen Windowed to unique **Fullscreen**.
- **Run as Administrator:**
  - Locate the game's .exe file, right-click, choose Properties, go to Compatibility, and inspect "Run this program as an administrator."
- **Disable Fullscreen Optimizations:**
  - In the exact same compatibility tab, inspect "Disable fullscreen optimizations" to reduce input lag and stuttering.

Guideline Description **Set a Budget** Only gamble with skins or currency you are fully prepared to lose completely. **Usage Two-Factor Authentication (2FA)** Secure your Steam account and betting platform accounts with mobile authenticators. **Take Regular Breaks** Step away from the screen when aggravation or tiredness sets in to preserve reasonable decision-making. **Treat it as Entertainment, Not Income** Never rely on gambling as a constant source of income or a method to upgrade a mediocre inventory.
