Clean is not satisfactory. The floor ought to additionally be dry to the core. On wooden, we search for moisture content material to fall less than 15 p.c. previously priming. On fiber cement and stucco, the outer surface can experience dry whereas the mass still holds water. Rushing primer onto damp siding traps moisture, which attempts to break out later, pushing the movie off as blisters.

Temperature, dew element, and wind velocity all outcome a paint movie.
