One-time passwords (OTPs) and verification codes are security mechanisms designed to confirm your identity. Proper handling of these codes is essential for maintaining security:

- **Do Not Share OTPs:** Never share OTPs with anyone via phone, chat, or social media, even if they claim to be support staff.
- **Be Wary of Screenshots:** Sharing screenshots that include OTPs or verification codes can put your account at risk if those images are intercepted or forwarded.
- **Be Mindful of Timing Issues:** If OTPs don't arrive or are rejected, do not request code spam; wait a few minutes as codes can expire quickly or be delayed.

Applying these principles protects your account from unauthorized access and social engineering attacks.



Step 6: Contact BingoPlus Support Safely if Issues Persist

If after performing the above steps the unexpected activity continues or you are locked out, contact **BingoPlus** support through their official website only. Avoid contacting anyone via random phone numbers or email addresses found in suspicious messages.

When submitting a support request, include the non-sensitive evidence you preserved and detailed descriptions of the issue. This helps the support team diagnose and fix your problem faster.
