3. The Interview: Questions to Ask

Do they use natural light or flash?. Ask about their equipment. Do they provide a sneak peek?. What is the hourly rate?. Do they charge for travel?. What happens if they get sick?. Ask about their contract. Ask for a sample. Are they friendly and unobtrusive?. A professional photographer will welcome these questions

4. Pricing and Budgeting

Here's what to expect. For a local, less experienced photographer. Expect to pay \$200–\$400 per hour. These photographers often have a minimum booking of 4–6 hours. Or slightly more. For a set number of hours. Like travel fees, parking, and editing fees. Ask about deposits. Ask about the hourly rate for extra time. And they're worth the investment. Set a budget range before you start searching. And create keepsakes that last a lifetime



5. The Contract: What to Include

It's time to sign the contract. And the duration of the shoot. Including the deposit and the balance due date. And what's not included. It should include a cancellation policy. It protects both parties. And behavior expectations. It should include a "backup plan". For their portfolio or marketing. Read the contract carefully. Keep a copy for your records. And ensures a smooth event

6. Capturing the Important Moments

This ensures that all the important moments are captured. Like the birthday person's entrance. And a photo of all the guests. Capture candid moments. Include details. And the general atmosphere. So they know what to

prioritize. That you might not have thought of. So they can make sure to get those shots. Like family drama. That you get the photos and videos you want



7. Logistics: Setup, Lighting, and Space

To ensure everything runs smoothly. Some venues have restrictions. Discuss the setup time with your photographer. And when. Ensure there's good lighting. Like the cake cutting or the toast. Have a "point person". Provide water and snacks. And good lighting. Make sure there's enough space. And allows the photographer to capture the best possible images

8. Troubleshooting Tips

Here's how to make sure your photographer runs smoothly. And make sure someone is there to greet them. And can plan their shots. Provide a timeline of events. If the timeline changes, let them know. A professional photographer will have backups. If they need a break, let them take one. If the event is long. A little extra goes a long way. Thank them personally. You've hired a professional

9. Editing and Delivery

This process can take several weeks. Ask about the turnaround time. Some photographers provide a "sneak peek". Color correction, retouching, and cropping. For videography, the editing process.
