

*Counter-Strike: Global Offensive* (CS: GO) has constantly been a game of continuous evolution, and the introduction of new weapon cases is among the most visible ways Valve keeps the meta <https://cs2skin.com/cases> fresh. Notes:

- The "Covert" rarity is the rarest tier and constantly appears as the perk item (knife or gloves).
- The portions shown are approximate and can move somewhat with each case patch.
- Prices on the Steam Market typically go beyond the in-game cost for highly sought-after skins.

## 3. Why These Cases Matter

### 3.1 Economy Influence

When a new case launches, the market reacts within hours. The **Recoil Case**, for instance, drove the cost of the *SCAR-20|Blueprint* (Mil-Spec) from £ 0.15 to £ 0.45 on the very first day. Alternatively, older cases like **Prisma** frequently see a price dip as supply stabilises.

### 3.2 Aesthetic Variety

Each case presents a distinct visual style. The **Revolution Case** leans into dynamic, graffiti-style artwork, while the **Recoil Case** embraces a more commercial, military-tech aesthetic. Gamers who gather themed loadouts can curate their inventory around these releases.

### 3.3 Odds and Value

Valve's current changes have actually partially increased the **Covert** drop rate (from 0.20% to 0.25%). While this might seem minimal, it makes opening a case slightly more rewarding for those chasing after a knife or gloves.
