What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live dealer video game built around a massive, vertically mounted 54-segment wheel. Hosted by an energetic, live speaker in a dynamic, Willy Wonka-esque studio, the video game streams in real-time to players around the globe.

Unlike standard table video games like blackjack or roulette, Crazy Time needs no complex memorization of rules or technique charts. How the Game is Played

Every game round starts with a betting stage. Players have a restricted time to position their chips on several of the 8 readily available betting options on the virtual design. These choices consist of 4 numbers (1, 2, 5, and 10) and four unique perk video games.

When betting closes, the live host spins the giant wheel. All at once, a separate two-reel slot positioned above the main wheel-- called the **Top Slot**-- spins alongside it.

The Top Slot Mechanism

Before the wheel stops, the Top Slot creates a random multiplier and appoints it to one of the 8 betting choices on the wheel.

- If the Top Slot multiplier and the wheel result line up on the same section, the multiplier uses to that win.
- If the outcome is a benefit video game, the multiplier improves all the multipliers *inside* that specific bonus round, resulting in possibly huge payouts.

Comprehending the Wheel Segments and Payouts

The 54 segments on the Crazy Time wheel are distributed amongst numbers and bonus games. Naturally, the lower-paying numbers appear much more frequently on the wheel than the unusual bonus offer rounds.

Breakdown of Wheel Segments

- **Number 1:** Appears 21 times (Payout: 1:1)
- **Number 2:** Appears 13 times (Payout: 2:1)
- **Number 5:** Appears 7 times (Payout: 5:1)
- **Number 10:** Appears 4 times (Payout: 10:1)
- **Coin Flip Bonus:** Appears 4 times
- **Cash Hunt Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Pachinko Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Crazy Time Bonus:** Appears 1 time

Dive Into the Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The true magic-- and the source of the game's greatest payouts-- lies within its 4 interactive perk rounds. Whenever the wheel lands on a perk section, players who positioned a bet on that specific function are transferred to a secondary game screen.

1. Coin Flip

The most basic of the four perks, this round features a coin with a red side and a blue side.

- Each side is appointed a random multiplier before the flip.
- The host presses a button to turn the coin, and whichever color lands face-up awards the corresponding multiplier to the player's bet.

2. Cash Hunt

This is a huge interactive shooting gallery including a screen with 108 random multipliers hidden behind different signs (like a cactus, target, or chef's hat).

- Gamers use a virtual crosshair to intend and contend a symbol of their option before a countdown timer ends.
- When time runs out, all symbols reveal their concealed multipliers, and the gamer wins whatever value they shot.

3. Pachinko

Influenced by the traditional Japanese arcade video game, Pachinko features a big wall filled with physical pegs.



- The host drops a puck from the top of the board.

- The puck bounces arbitrarily down the pegs up until it lands in one of the slots at the bottom, which contains a multiplier.
- If the puck lands in a **"DOUBLE"** slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again for an even bigger payment.

4. Crazy Time

The crown gem of the video game. When activated, the host opens a red door leading into a surreal, vibrantly colored virtual world including a huge, 64-segment mega-wheel.

- Players must pick among three flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow**.
- The host spins the wheel, and the flapper the gamer selected determines their reward.
- This wheel includes **"DOUBLE"** and **"TRIPLE"** sectors. If the flapper indicate among these, all multipliers on the wheel increase, and the wheel spins once again-- enabling wins to scale approximately the video game's optimum cap of 500,000 x!

Techniques for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is ultimately a video game of opportunity determined by RNG and physics, players typically utilize various betting strategies to manage their bankroll and maximize their time playing.

Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe/Conservative Strategy:** Betting heavily on the numbers (1 and 2) along with a small cover bet on the bonus rounds. This method yields regular, smaller sized wins, keeping the bankroll steady for longer durations.
- **The Bonus-Only Strategy:** Ignoring the numbers completely and putting little bets solely on the four bonus rounds (Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, and Crazy Time). This technique is high-risk, high-reward, as it relies on hitting the fairly rare benefit sections to see a return.
- **The Spread Strategy:** Placing bets across a variety of sectors (numbers and benefits alike) to guarantee that a high portion of the wheel yields some kind of return.

Necessary Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed home entertainment spending plan before logging in and never chase losses.
- **Understand Volatility:** Bonus rounds do not hit on every spin. Anticipate droughts while waiting for a benefit to activate.
- **Bet Entertainment:** Remember that live gambling establishment video games are developed primarily for enjoyable and entertainment, not as a reliable source of earnings.
